CHALLENGES

“Many times former engineers turn JD have a hard time with PM saying there are just too many unknowns”

“...The biggest threat is complacency. We in the field and as a group of professionals need to continue to add value and move the industry forward”

“LPM needs resources and skills that may not reside solely in the LPM, herself. Firm must actualize LPM through resource grants - team will need dedicated resources...”

SUMMARY

The general consensus is that the industry will likely continue to grow and transition into something more complex and more dedicated.

“Something like engineering for legal work. Designing micro-solutions to incoming bespoke problems, collating seemingly different ideas into larger more permanent solutions that don't require oversight.”

“... A consolidation of administration within law firms, break down the traditional silos of the admin departments and really become a matrix organisation.”

“...The role will continue to grow and adapt to changes within our firm and the broader marketplace. Focusing on efficiency and quality of internal processes and the delivery of legal services.”
